
Bank of Saint Lucia Cheque Security Features

Chemical Sensitive Stains

In-paper colour indicators that are added during paper making that react to chemicals

True Watermark An in-paper feature created by the paper machine during the sheet formation



Bleed Through MICR

(Magnetic Ink Character

Recognition) Special ink used to print the following information: cheque number, account number and routing number located at the bottom of the cheque. This information is visible on the reverse of the cheque.

Invisible Fluorescent Fibers

Randomly placed fibers of various lengths and colours that are visible in UV light

Visible Fibers

Randomly placed fibers of various lengths and colours that are included in paper finish
